

Whitby Golf Club - Course Safety

**FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS,
PLEASE BE ADVISED:**



In the event of an electrical storm, suspend play immediately & take appropriate action. (Rule 6-8a applies). Shelters on the course do not provide adequate protection from lightning.



Do not commence or continue play in fog/poor visibility, when you cannot see the clear distance of your intended shot.



Greens staff working on the course have priority at all times.



HOLES 2, 3, 9 & 16: Report all incidences of balls being struck onto the public road to the clubhouse or Professional's shop. (This is for monitoring purposes only.)



The Course, it's Steps and Surfaces may be slippery when damp or wet. Golfers must ensure to wear appropriate footwear to meet the conditions of the day. Wherever possible, keep to Footpaths & Steps.

HOLES 4 & 5: Take extra care near the cliff edge, to the left of these holes.



HOLES 6 & 18: Golfers must not tee off at these holes if there are walkers on the public footpath between the red and white posts. Priority must be given to users of public footpaths.



Report all accidents to the Pro's shop or Clubhouse as soon as possible.

**GOLFERS ARE REMINDED THAT THEY HAVE A DUTY OF CARE FOR THEMSELVES
AND ALL OTHER COURSE USERS.**



- If you strike a ball toward others call "FORE!" in a clear audible voice.
- If you hear a call of "FORE!" cover your head & count to ten.
- Particular care should be taken where holes are in close proximity and where golfers on other holes are in range.
- Please adhere to instructions, regarding priority and safety, given on tee signs around the course.

You are advised to carry a mobile phone (*switched off*) to summon assistance in an emergency. **RING 999 OR 112 FOR AN AMBULANCE**
